Hayle Area Action Plan Background

- > Issues and Options Paper
- **➤ Consultation January March 2008**
- > 281 completed questionnaires
- > 180 other representations
- > Plus consultee comments
- Collated and analysed
- Pointers for progression
- **➤** Report to SEE Committee 30 July

- ➤ General support for regeneration and development, <u>but</u>...
- > Concerns about:
 - Scale of development proposed
 - Need for appropriate level and balance of development
 - Current lack of and requirement for supporting infrastructure, facilities and services to meet community needs

- Vision and Objectives supported, but...
- > Need to emphasize:
 - Environmental issues
 - Biodiversity (protection and new opportunities)
 - Green infrastructure provision
 - Exploitation of green energy
 - Affordable housing
 - Sustainable employment opportunities

- Harbour supported as key development opportunity, but...
 - Notable measure of opposition to associated greenfield development
 - Corresponding support for consideration of alternative opportunities

- Support for development of suggested 'broad growth area':
 - Penpol Road St George's Road High Lanes – Viaduct Hill 'corridor'
 - Potential Sites H14-23

- Support for development of all sites within 'broad growth area' for housing, <u>but</u>...together with:
 - Educational infrastructure (H14-17)
 - Community facilities (H14, H16)
 - Sports / leisure facilities (H14-17, H18, H21-23)
 - Extra care housing (H14-17, H19) (plus H28)

- Further afield, little support for development of land:
 - Beyond A30 Hayle Bypass (H29)
 - At Riviere Farm / Phillack area (H10-12) (<u>but</u>...White-Water Sports Centre)
 - Surrounding / overlooking Lelant Water (H24, H39, H40)
 - Off Water Lane / Mellanear Road (H24-27, but...H28?)
 - Between Marsh Lane and Angarrack (H34)

- **>** <u>But</u>...support for:
 - Strategy focusing industrial / business uses in vicinity of St Erth roundabout (H36-37, H41-42, and...H38?)
 - Employment development in Loggans
 Moor Marsh Lane area (H30-33)
- > Together with:
 - More centralised employment opportunities (live/work)

- > Within the town, support for:
 - Development of previously-developed sites
 - Harbour key opportunity (housing, employment, shopping)

> Plus:

- Foundry heritage centre, business
- R & J Supplies housing, emergency services / health centre, shopping, sports /leisure (cinema), business (live/work)
- Hawkin's Motors recreation / open space, housing
- Daniel's Supermarket <u>shopping</u>, housing, business

> Plus:

- Atlantic Motors Housing, recreation / open space, <u>shopping</u>, business
- Central Garage housing, shopping, business
- Loggans Mill housing, business

Feedback

- > But...need to ensure:
 - Supporting infrastructure, facilities and services
 - Range of integrated community, entertainment, and sports / leisure facilities (e.g. HAC, cinema)
 - Public transport improvements (e.g. station)
 - Safeguarding of land for school expansion / new provision
 - Provision for healthcare and emergency services

- Functional areas (Community Networks?)
- Hayle role, function, potential?
- Level of development? (RSS / capacity / land availability /alternative strategies?)

Hayle Area Action Plan

Progression

➤ Ongoing Work:

- Site assessment (opportunities, constraints)
- Transport Study / Strategy (accessibility, traffic impact, mitigation measures, including public transport, e.g. station)
- Other Infrastructure
 - Schools (CCC)
 - Healthcare (PCT / GPs)
 - Emergency services (Fire, others)
 - Community facilities (HAC)
 - Other (town centre facilities, e.g. cinema)

Hayle Area Action Plan Progression

- ➤ Not forgetting...
 - Hayle Harbour
 - Outline Planning Application
 - Ongoing assessment / pending determination
 - Need for consideration / coordination as part of AAP
 - Public opinion

Hayle Area Action Plan Progression

> Next Steps:

- Dependent upon RSS / Cornwall LDF
- Further reports (RSS, LDS, HAAP)
- Preparation of indicative 'concept' plan (Growth Area) for Hayle
- Community involvement
- Refinement of options
- Formulation of 'preferred' options
