PLANS TO BE REVEALED FOR MORRISONS' TOWN CENTRE STORE

Developer, Actoris Ltd, will soon unveil its plans for the proposed new Morrisons supermarket in Hayle town centre. A planning application will shortly be submitted for the Jewson site at Carnsew Quay. The developers believe that this scheme offers a preferable and viable alternative to existing proposals for other supermarket sites in and around the town.

The planning application for the 3-acre site will comprise a 36,000 sq ft foodstore, along with approximately 250 parking spaces. Unlike rival out-of-town schemes, this site will complement the existing town centre retail offer rather than enticing shoppers off the streets and into their cars. It is hoped that the enhanced parking facilities will benefit Hayle town centre as a whole, with shoppers choosing to visit other facilities in addition to the supermarket.

The developers believe the site's location offers the convenience of a town-centre location, but does not compromise the town's heritage or blight views of the South Quay.

Matt Bryant, of Actoris, comments: "We are committed to deliver a solution that enhances, rather than detracts from, the town centre. As such, we believe that our proposals both respect the sensitivities of developing within a major historic conservation area and answer the needs of the local community".

Representatives from Actoris Ltd and Morrisons will be hosting a series of public presentations on Friday, 19 February (between 10am and 7pm) and Saturday, 20 February (10am-2pm) at the Denis Hollow Room, Passmore Edwards Institute, Hayle.
