

Copperhouse Pool – Waterside Walkway

Copperhouse Pool is an important part of Hayle and provides a link between Copperhouse and Foundry. The pool and surrounding area provide a range of recreational activities from water sports and bird watching to pleasant strolls along the sub-tropical gardens on King George V Memorial Walk.

One of the objectives of the Hayle Townscape Heritage Initiative was to provide a 360 degree walkway around the pool and this concept has been carried forward to the Hayle Area Plan Partnership.

Following meetings and consultations we now have a draft plan which will provide both a well-designed and signposted circular path combined with integration into the commercial areas of Copperhouse.

We now invite comments on this draft.

It would be useful to have your views by 31 March, 2009, after which the details for receipt of your response may change. But there is no deadline as yet. It is proposed to begin work by planning refurbishments at Copperhouse, close to the historic dock, and it will take some time to plan and raise funds for the work required.
